

Workshop III: Strengthening accountability and sharing responsibilities - How to improve the implementation of future EU and national environmental policies

Various assessments of both the current and previous Environment Action Programmes conclude that their implementation at the EU and national level is insufficient. If, however, the EAPs are not properly implemented, they risk becoming paper exercises.

Successful implementation in a multi-governance system such as the EU requires cooperation between a large number of actors. The objective of this workshop is to try to identify new ways of how policy makers and different stakeholder groups could successfully collaborate in the implementation of a future Environment Action Programme. We will look at upstream actions (e.g. infringements) and downstream examples (e.g. grassroots and bottom-up initiatives), as well as ways to create ownership in clearly defined stakeholder groups. The ultimate outcome of the workshop should be practical ideas for both content and structure of an 8EAP.
